

Terrapin Wetsuits measuring instructions for custom booties

You'll need help from another person to trace your foot while you're standing straight.

- 1) Stand barefooted on a piece of paper larger than your foot, placed on a flat surface (not cushioned or carpeted). Stand straight up with your weight on that foot.
- 2) Have another person trace the outline of your foot onto the paper. Be sure to hold the pen or pencil perpendicular to the floor, and trace as close as possible around the foot.
- 3) Slip a tape measure under the widest part of the foot so that it's sticking out at the ball of the foot on one side. Again, with your weight on that foot, measure the circumference of the foot with the tape measure. Mark on the paper where the tape measure crosses the outline of the foot (both sides), and write the circumference on the paper at these marks.
- 4) Now slide the tape measure back to the instep of the foot and measure the circumference in the same way, so that the tape goes over the arch of the foot. Mark the paper on both sides where the tape crosses the outline, and write down the circumference you measured.
- 5) Measure the circumference of the ankle at the smallest point, and write down the ankle measurement on the paper. Don't worry, the bootie will be looser than this measurement, so there will be room to get your foot through the ankle area.
- 6) Our standard bootie height is 8", but if you want a different height, let me know. Measure up from the floor. Write down the height.
- 7) Measure up from the floor to the height you selected, and measure the circumference of the calf at that point. Write down this top circumference on the paper.
- 8) Select the color and thickness of neoprene for the sides of the booties (3mm or 5mm)
- 9) Select the color of the sole, if you want a hard-sole bootie.
- 10) Select whether you want zippers on the inside of the bootie shafts.

I recommend you print this document twice, and use the backside of one for each foot: left & right.
